

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF BLYTHEVILLE, ARKANSAS
May 23, 2022 – 3:00 P.M.**

The City Council of the City of Blytheville, Arkansas met by zoom in a special called meeting at 3:00 p.m. May 23, 2022. Present were Mayor James Sanders, City Clerk Melody Lawson, City Attorney Chris Brown, and the following Council Members: Vera James, Barbara McAdoo-Brothers, R.L. Jones, Matt Perrin, John Musgraves, and John Mayberry. The meeting was called to order by Mayor James W. Sanders. A letter and waiver of notice are on file in the office of the City Clerk. The press was represented by Marcus McClain.

The Mayor asked for a motion to waive the approval of the minutes from the previous meeting to the next regular meeting. Jones made the motion, seconded by Mayberry, vote (5/0). Musgraves was present but due to technical problems could not hear his vote.

Jones offered the Resolution, which was read in full by the City Clerk. Jones made the motion, seconded by McAdoo-Brothers, to adopt the Resolution, vote 4/0 with Mayberry abstaining.

There being no further business before the council, McAdoo-Brothers made the motion, seconded by Perrin, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously and the Mayor declared the meeting adjourned.
