

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF BLYTHEVILLE, ARKANSAS  
June 21, 2022 - 5:00 P.M.

The City Council of the City of Blytheville, Arkansas met in regular session at the Ritz Civic Center on June 21, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Present were Mayor James Sanders, City Clerk Melody Lawson, and the following Council Members: Barbara McAdoo-Brothers, Matt Perrin, R.L. Jones, John Mayberry, and John Musgraves. Council Member Vera James and City Attorney Chris Brown were absent

The invocation was given by Reverend Willie Williams (Faith Temple House of Prayer).

Mayor Sanders led the pledge of allegiance.

The Mayor asked for the council's wishes on approval of the minutes from the May 17, 2022 regular meeting and the May 23, 2022 special meeting. Jones made the motion, seconded by Musgraves to accept the minutes of the May 17, 2022 regular meeting and the May 23, 2022 special meeting as prepared by the City Clerk, vote 5/0.

The Mayor asked if anyone in attendance wished to address the council on agenda items. Council Member John Mayberry asked to discuss item 3 for clarification.

McAdoo-Brothers offered the Resolution, which was read in full by the City Clerk. Jones made the motion, seconded by Musgraves, to adopt the Resolution, the vote was 5/0.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022:32

*CONDEMNING CERTAIN STRUCTURES WITHIN THE CITY OF BLYTHEVILLE, ARKANSAS*

McAdoo-Brothers offered the Resolution, which was read in full by the City Clerk. Jones made the motion, seconded by McAdoo-Brothers, to adopt the Resolution with the removal of address 802 S. Lilly, the vote was 4/1. Perrin voted no.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022:33

*AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET*
