

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL

April 21, 2020 – 5:00 P.M.**

In accordance with Governor Asa Hutchinson's Executive Order 20-03 restricting gatherings to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Blytheville City Council held its first virtual Council meeting at 5:00 p.m. April 21, 2020. Mayor James W. Sanders conducted the meeting from City Hall via the teleconferencing app, Zoom. Joining in remotely were: City Clerk Connie Mosley-Brents, City Attorney Chris Brown and Council Members Barbara McAdoo-Brothers, Matt Perrin, R. L. Jones, John Musgraves, John Mayberry and Vera James. The press was represented by Jonet' Washington.

The invocation was given by Bishop R.L. Jones.

Mayor Sanders led the pledge of allegiance.


