
On behalf of the City of Blytheville, CWB Engineers, Inc. received and opened bids for Elm Street & Byrum Rd Improvements on July 20, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. The certified bid tabulation is attached to this letter of recommendation. The bids received for the above referenced project are summarized below:

<i>Bidder</i>	<i>Base Bid</i>	<i>Base Bid with Deductive Alternate Removed</i>
Jowers General Contracting Inc.	\$1,566,171.00	\$1,327,103.50
Hessling Construction	\$1,798,330.47	\$1,499,316.42

The Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) was \$1,737,940 base bid and \$1,511,190.00 with Deductive Alternate removed. We recommend awarding the contract to Jowers General Contracting Inc. from Blytheville, Arkansas, for the base bid amount of \$1,566,171.00, which includes the additional work in the Dogwood area. The contractor is currently licensed with the Arkansas Contractor's Licensing Board to perform Municipal and Utility Construction. We feel like this bid represents a good value in the current economy.
