

He went back to talk again to his super. when the officer came back to the car + told me his super. said that signing the ticket was saying I was guilty or not. 

I WAS WALKING AGAINST THE TRAFFIC AS I WAS SUPPOSED TO ON THE AIRBASE HIGHWAY ABOUT 1/4 OF A MILE FROM ONE-STOP TO BLYTHEVILLE WHEN I LOOKED UP AND SAW A BLYTHEVILLE PATROL OFFICER, CAUCASIAN WITH BLACK HAIR DRIVING RECKLESSLY IN A BLYTHEVILLE PATROL CAR GOING TOWARD GOSWELL. IT OCCURRED AT 10:30 AM.			
AS I EXAMINED THE SITUATION CLOSER, THE VEHICLE WAS NOT WITHIN AN EMERGENCY CAPACITY AS NO LIGHTS OR SIRENS WERE PRESENTLY OPERATING WITHIN AN EMERGENCY CAPACITY UPON THE VEHICLE. THE OFFICER LAUGHED ABOUT THE SITUATION. IT WAS NOT FEARFUL.			
THE OFFICER WAS TALKING ON A CELL PHONE AS HE DROVE RECKLESSLY TOWARD ME AS I WAS WALKING ON THE FAR RIGHT SHOULDER OF AIRBASE HIGHWAY NEAR THE ABOVE MENTIONED LOCATION OF THE OCCURRENCE. I FEARED HE WAS TRYING TO RUN ME OVER.			
MY COMPLAINT STATES THAT A CAUCASIAN BLYTHEVILLE POLICE OFFICER CAME BARRELING TOWARD ME IN HIS OFFICIAL DUTY AS A POLICE OFFICER. THE OFFICER USED HIS SQUAD CAR TO TRY TO INTIMIDATE ME AS IF I HAD DONE SOMETHING WRONG. THIS INTIMIDATION/HARASSMENT CREATED AN IMMEDIATE FEAR FOR MY SAFETY AND WELL BEING. MY COMPLAINT STATES THAT THE OFFICER WAS OUT OF CONTROL WHILE DRIVING HIS SQUAD CAR DUE TO THE USE OF A CELLPHONE. AT THAT MOMENT I FEARED FOR MY LIFE WHEN THE OCCURRENCE HAPPENED. I HAVE BEEN MENTALLY TRAUMATIZED THIS SITUATION.

I went back in the house and called 911 two times around 10:26am or 10:30am. It took the Police 25 to 30 min. to come. Dog went back of his house, from which he came. I talked to Officer Polk about the incident, he said we couldn't file a complaint. Just telling him was sufficient. The officers went next door to the officer which own the dog. While we were waiting in our house for a reply from the officers, they never came and told us anything, they left.

Our witnesses across the street saw the dog also, through their front door. The fence in back of my neighbors' yard will not secure the dog. A stronger fence, a secure fence should be installed for the dog. This is the second time we have been frightened of this dog. We never know when he will try again, or anyone else he might approach. We were late for church because of this incident. We are like prisoners in our own home. The officers never apologize or anything.
