

Describe event

A Sgt from Blytheville P.D. said I, my sons and grandson could not be there. I told her we drove through the field and out to the walking trail. And, upon this date I crossed over the trail, I am an 80% disabled vet, retired USAF. She contacted her tour Co. He stated the "Chief of Police did not want anyone out there". On her way to tell us, whites, she passed by a vehicle of blacks. The Sgt left the area. I called 763 4411 to ask that "the car with the blacks should be told they had to go". The Sgt came back to tell the blacks they had to go. I waited at the entrance to the area for the Sgt, when she came out she said "See I told the blacks they had to go". I asked her to enforce the other posted laws, she had the Lt. Come out: when he arrived I asked the Lt + Sgt to enforce the "Keep off Grass". Both said they would not. The Blytheville Gestapo only enforces laws it wants to, and against what it wants. The Chief of Gosnell never makes the laws as to where people can & cannot go instead of the City Council. Mayor Harrison said so long as I did not use the walking trail I could go out there. Now the Gestapo says, the Gestapo now makes the law and enforces the laws they want and refuse those they desire as demonstrated on 6 Apr. 12 p. 17.

I would like to bring to your attention an awful experience from this past Friday night. The event that I will detail below has left me feeling that I live in area where we are less cared for and don't matter. The police department showed lack of concern and disrespect to many concerned citizens and this should never be the case.

My family and I reside on East Rose St, between Holland and Walker. It was approximately 10:00 p.m. Friday September 14, 2012, when we heard gun shots ring out in close proximity of our residence. Immediately I grabbed the telephone and dialed 911. The dispatcher answered and I advised her that I couldn't remember the non-emergency number so I called 911 to report that we just heard gunshots outside of our home and saw someone run across the front lawn.

After hanging up, I looked outside and could see someone laying on my neighbor's lawn. A young man had been shot. My neighbor picked up her phone to call 911; I informed her that I had already placed the call for assistance. We tried to help the hurt man until the police arrived. To our dismay the police was nowhere in sight. After waiting over 15 minutes, the victim was transported by car away from the scene.

Many of my neighbors gathered to discuss the disturbance of gun shots and actually seeing the victim. In the distance we could see a police car slowly approaching. This was over 20 minutes after the call to 911. The officer didn't bother to stop, ask questions, show interest or do anything remotely close to what should be done under these circumstances.

I would like to believe that there was a communication error but I know all too well that it wasn't. This area does have crime but it also has concerned citizens that try to change that. The actions of the Blytheville Police Department are shameful. The vow to protect and serve isn't limited by the number of calls, crimes, race, religion or what side of the track one lives on. The mission of the Blytheville Police Department is to **provide the community with a quality, progressive law enforcement service, that suppresses and eliminates criminal activity, promotes a positive perception of the community, and address all conditions that have a detrimental impact on public safety. To fulfill our mission we must continually seek the respect, support and cooperation from the community we serve on the fundamental principle that the public and police are one.** The mission reads well, but it's just lost words with no true action. In fact, the actions my neighbors and I experienced are the exact opposite of which you all boast to adhere to. In order to help an area the citizens as well as the police have to work together. The lack of action by the Blytheville police instills the notion that "we don't matter". Is this truly the way you would want your organization looked upon?

Respectfully, I ask that you advise me on the reason behind the lack of response. I would also like to know what steps the police department plan to enact to help change the perception of the police in this area; as well as what will be done to decrease the crime.

I then turned by back & put ~~my~~ my hands behind my backs for my handcuffs & to be read my rights. After officer Richardson came in he then asked me to just go into the cell. Officer Kevin #539 then came & got me back out of the cell & gave me my citation to be in court.
