

ORDINANCE NO. 920

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING NUMBERING OF ALL HOUSES,
BUILDINGS, OR OTHER STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF
BLYTHEVILLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLYTHEVILLE,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION ONE: It shall be the duty of the owners and occupants
of every house, building, or other structure in the City of Blytheville,
to have placed thereon, or on another structure located on said property,
in a place clearly visible from the street, figures at least $2\frac{1}{4}$ inches
high, showing the number of the house, building, or other structure.
Said numbers shall be in a contrasting color to the structure they
are placed on. This requirement in no way restricts the owner or
occupant of said house, building or other structure to place additional
numbers on said property designating the official number of the said
property.

SECTION TWO: Any person, firm or corporation failing to
so number any house, building, or other structure owned or occupied
by him as set out above, or if after receiving 10 days notice from
the Blytheville Permits, Inspection and Code Enforcement Office, shall
continue in his failure to so number such house, building, or other
structure, shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance and upon
conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.00;
Each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION THREE: All numbering shall be numbered in accordance
with the number designated by the Permits, Inspection and Code Enforce-
ment Office of the City of Blytheville as the official number of said
house, building, or other structure.

SECTION FOUR: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall take effect on December 31,
1974.
